If necessary, the matter will be brought to the attention of the Children's Services, the matter will be discussed and dealt with in the strictest confidence.

Where parents/carers are not satisfied that their child is receiving the free entitlement in the correct way (as set out in this funding agreement and in Early Education and Childcare Statutory guidance for local authorities), a complaint can be submitted directly to either the Manager (Jayne Rayner) or Trustee (Hannah King).

Complaints can be made either in person, or via email, letter or phone call.

The matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence and wherever necessary a solution to the problem will be sought. The parent/carer will be kept informed of the progress being made in dealing with their complaint and notified wherever possible of any outcome or action taken.

OFSTED may be informed of the complaint and their advice sought as required. Details of the complaint made, and its outcome will be recorded by the Manager and kept on file.

It is hoped that all complaints will be made constructively and in return they will be dealt with sensitively. We aim for action to be prompt and to the satisfaction of all parties.



If the parent/ carer is dissatisfied with the outcome of their complaint or feels that they would prefer to take the matter further, this may be done by contacting either OFSTED, the office for standards in education.
